

Code of Conduct and Backstage Information for Dancers

The Spring Concert is an exciting time for all involved and we have created this Code of Conduct to ensure that all dancers have a positive experience. Dancers and parents, please read over this and take the time to review it with your child. If you have any questions, please feel free to email or call us at the studio.

Code of Conduct

During the performance and backstage ALL dancers will:

- Stay in their assigned dressing area for safety and so we can have a smooth performance. We need to know where ALL of our dancers are at ALL times. You may not go to another area make-up, food, and clothing or to play. Even bathroom breaks require permission!
- In your words and actions, show respect for the parent volunteers, the Ballet Arts Staff and your fellow dancers.
- Help keep your dressing room neat. Please pick/wipe up anything you drop or spill.
- Avoid panicking! If you have a broken strap, a missing shoe, or anything that needs attention, please tell your parent volunteer immediately—they have volunteered their time to help you!

Backstage Basics

- 1) Please put your name inside all of your costume pieces and inside each of your shoes, snack bag, water bottle and make-up and hair supplies.
- 2) Please bring a large, button down shirt or bathrobe to cover your costume when you are not performing. Bring something comfortable to sit on like a blanket or beach towel as well.
- 3) Please bring snacks, food and drinks that are clean to eat. For example, water instead of grape soda. pretzels instead of cheetos.
- 4) Please bring something to work or play with while you are in your dressing room area. Homework, books, card games, MP3 player, portable DVD player etc
